

# CHINESE EXPERIENCE

(05 Nights and 06 Days Tour)

## DAY 01: BEIJING

Arrive Beijing, the capital of China. To be met at the airport then transferred to your hotel. Evening at leisure in the evening. Overnight at the hotel.

## DAY 02: BEIJING

Depart from your hotel after breakfast. Spending about 1.5 hours to be transferred outside the city to the surrounding countryside to visit the Badaling Great Wall, one of the most remarkable feats of mankind, built over 2,000 years ago. Visit the fabled Ming Tombs, the resting places of thirteen emperors and their splendid treasures. you will encounter the marble tombs of the Ming Dynasty emperors. Visit one of the spectacular tombs-Dingling-featuring an underground palace. Overnight at the hotel. **(B)**

## DAY 03: BEIJING

Depart from your hotel in the morning to have city tours to visit Tiananmen Square, It is the biggest public square in the world, which can hold one million people. Have a free walk there, imagining the great historic events of the 20th century that took place there. You will also see legendary landmarks including the Great Hall of the People and the towering 125 foot granite obelisk. Walking across the Golden River Bridge, enter the Forbidden City, the inner sanctum and palace where for centuries Chinese emperors ruled their world. It has a 9000-room maze of courtyards, palaces, and ceremonial halls, where 24 emperors used to live. Visit the Summer Palace. Built in 1888, it was once a summer retreat for emperors. Have a lakeside cruise on lovely Kunming Lake, enjoy the magical views of the hills, bridges and pagodas that grace the Palace grounds. Overnight at the hotel. **(B)**

## DAY 04: BEIJING - SHANGHAI

Morning check out of the hotel and transfer to Beijing South station to board G101 to Shanghai at 0700 hours. Arrive Shanghai at 1223 hours. Transfer and check in at your hotel. Leave to visit the Bund. Take a walking tour along the waterfront to experience the sights and sounds of the old "Wall Street" in Shanghai. Banks, trading houses and along the famous shopping street-Nanjing Road. It is said that shopping in Shanghai is the most varied and rewarding in China. Visit the Yu Garden. It is well worth a meander through the Yu Garden, which has many scenic courtyards decorated with baroque rockery, pools and flora, all connected by corridors and passageways. Follow with the Jade Buddha Temple. Built in 1911, it is the most famous and one of the most active Buddhist temples in Shanghai. Overnight at the hotel. **(B)**

## DAY 05: SHANGHAI

Depart after breakfast from your hotel to visit the Shanghai Museum. As a museum of ancient Chinese art, the Shanghai Museum possesses a collection of 120,000 precious works of art. Its rich and high-quality collection of ancient Chinese bronze, ceramics, paintings and calligraphy is specially celebrated in the world. After having lunch at a nice local restaurant, visit the Shanghai Oriental Pearl TV Tower. At 468 meters high (1,536 feet), the tower is the third tallest TV and radio tower in the world as well as the tallest structure in Asia. The viewing area is half-way up and offers a splendid unparalleled view of the emerging new modern Shanghai! Enjoy a wonderful acrobatic show later in the evening. Overnight at the Hotel. **(B)**

## DAY 06 : TRANSFER BACK - HOME

After breakfast, checkout and transfer to Shanghai airport for your flight back to India or your next destination. **(B)**
